The Chairman opened the meeting.

"Good evening Ladies and Gentlemen. I now open this short meeting. You have all seen the Examiner's report on our Neighbourhood Plan and the amendments which have been made by Tandridge District Council to accommodate them. We have been asked by Tandridge District Council whether we accept those amendments before the plan proceeds to Referendum. A number of us have expressed informally their reservations about several aspects of the Examiner's report and the amendments, in particular the removal of the specific policy on downsizing which was in the submission plan and the revised wording on parking at the station. However, I think the general feeling is that the plan has emerged from the process overall in very good shape and deserves to proceed to Referendum. I therefore propose the following resolution:

"That Woldingham Parish Council accepts the Woldingham Neighbourhood Plan as amended by Tandridge Council and received by the Parish Clerk on 4th February, together with any further editorial amendments accepted by the Parish Clerk"
